## INDOOR GOLF - BOARD GAME

**Board game with five spinners**

One composite hole, play 18 times for different distances  
Five spinners represent different clubs  
Show result of stroke - distance, penalties and hazards  
10" x 20"

## BUDDY SAND SLED

**Rectangular sled / flat boat beach toy, 12 x 4 in. - 25¢**

Beach toy for small tots - on sand or in water  
Multiple versions add artwork and color  
12" x 4" x 2 1/2" deep; By 1925

## HOPEWELL FLYER

**Dirigible - Wind-up propeller, 8 ft. string - 25¢**

Wind-up mechanical spring motor in gondola  
Hang from ceiling on 8 ft. thread, swings in 6 ft. circle  
9" long; By 1926-1928

## HOPEWELL TWIN FLYER

**Spin a pair of dirigibles on a pedestal - \$1**

Two Hopewell Flyer dirigibles, without winding mechanism  
Pull cord on base to spin; pull-string is self-retracting  
12" wide x 14" high, 9" dirigibles; By 1926-1927

## HOPEWELL E-Z-GO-ROUND

**Spinning carousel - Horses & child riders - \$1**

Topped by "Hopewell" pennant with gold lettering  
Pull cord on base to spin; pull-string is self-retracting  
8 1/4" diam. x 7" high (10" to pennant); By 1928
